



## PERSONAL ITEMS

**Fukusa**, 帛紗 12" square silk cloth, women, red; men, purple.

**Kobukusa**, 古帛紗 brocade cloth, for under chawan. 6" square.

**Kaishi** – 懐紙 pack of folded white papers for sweets, about 3 x 6" when folded.

**Okeiko-gi** お稽古着 practice vest; or wear a wide belt.

**Sensu** – 扇子 fan: small folding fan (6" for women, 7" for men).

**Fukusa basami** - wallet for items.

## FOR HEATING WATER

**Tetsubin**, 鉄瓶 iron hot water kettle (5-6" D, handle over top). Or thermal carafe.

**Binkake**, 瓶掛 portable brazier, or hotplate for kettle.

## TEA & SWEETS

**Matcha** - 抹茶 green powdered tea, use "ceremonial grade"

**Okashi** - (和菓子 wa-gashi or 乾菓子 hi-gashi): small molded sweets, baked cakes w. sweet bean paste filling, dried fruit.

## MIZUYA (kitchen) ITEMS

**Fine mesh sieve & container**  
**Small funnel**  
**Wax paper** (about 8 x 10")  
**Bowl of water**  
**Cloth towel**



## DOGU - TEA UTENSILS

**Bon** - 盆 tray. 11" D, 1" H rim.

山道盆 Yamamichi bon, Mountain path, black w red trim

**Natsume** - 棗 lacquered tea caddy, 2 1/4 D x 2 1/2" H.

**Chawan** - 茶碗 tea bowl with a foot, generally 4 1/2 - 5" D x 3" H,.

**Chasen** - 茶筴 bamboo tea whisk, 80-120 tines.

**Chashaku** - 茶杓 bamboo tea scoop, approx. 7" long.

**Chakin** - 茶巾 white hemp & linen cloth, 6" x 11 1/2"

**Kensui** – 建水 a metal/ceramic bowl for waste-water with wide mouth, 5" D x 3" H.

**Small Serving** tray for sweets.
