
## Chado - The Way of Tea

## Rikyu's 7 rules

- 1. Make a satisfying bowl of tea.
- 2. Lay the charcoal so that the water boils efficiently.
- 3. Provide a sense of warmth in winter, coolness in summer.
- 4. Arrange the flowers as though they were in the field.
- 5. Be ready ahead of time.
- 6. Be prepared in case it should rain.
- 7. Act with utmost consideration toward your guests.
